

Twins Postpone Game & Groundbreaking Due to Tragedy

The **Minnesota Twins** announced tonight that they have postponed the Thursday afternoon game vs. Kansas City because of the tragic events which took place on the I-35W bridge in Minneapolis.

At least six people were killed when an interstate bridge in Minneapolis, Minnesota, collapsed Wednesday evening, plunging cars and chunks of concrete into the Mississippi River below.
