

Rockies To Use Solar-Powered LED Board in '07

The **Colorado Rockies** announced today that beginning on Opening Day, Monday, April 2, 2007, 46 solar panels have been installed to provide power at Coors Field. The panels and agreement are between the Rockies and **Xcel Energy**.

The 9.89 kilowatt solar array will produce over 14,000 kilowatt hours of energy, reportedly enough to offset the consumption of the Rockpile LED board over one year. In the walkway just under the system, a flatpanel monitoring system will show fans the real time consumption of the Rockpile LED board as well as the real time energy production from the solar array.
