

## Texas Rangers Lower Some Weekday Ticket Prices Through End of Regular Season

The Texas Rangers today announced a new ticket discount that will enable fans to save up to 75% on Monday through Thursday games in August and September.

Southwest Airlines Weekday Values will be in effect for all Monday through Thursday home games beginning with the Minnesota contest on Monday, August 17.

Fans can enter DINGER as the coupon code on [texasrangers.com](http://texasrangers.com) to purchase Upper Box, Upper Reserved, and Grandstand Reserved tickets for \$5 or Lexus Club Terrace, Lower Reserved, or Bleachers seats for \$10. That's a savings of up to 75%.

[Currently](#), the gate price for Upper Box is \$20, Upper Reserved is \$16 for adults (\$6 for kids under 13), Grandstand Reserved is \$6 (\$3 for kids under 13), Lexus Club Terrace seats are \$45, Lower Reserved are \$25, and Bleacher seats are currently priced at the gate at \$16 (\$6 for kids under 13).
