MLB Network will re-air Philadelphia Phillies Roy Halladay's no-hitter from Game One of the 2010 NLDS tonight at 1:00 a.m. ET/10:00 p.m. PT and 4:00a.m. ET/1:00 a.m. PT. Halladay threw the second no-hitter in Postseason history, defeating the Cincinnati Reds 4-0 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia. In 1956, New York Yankees pitcher Don Larsen pitched a perfect game during Game Five of the World Series against the Brooklyn Dodgers.
